All clinic services are available by appointment. Walk-ins are accepted as staffing allows. Most services are provided based upon income. Some services have a flat rate.

Well Child Exams

Periodic screenings from birth up to 21 years old. School and Sports physicals are also offered.

WIC (Women, Infants & Children)
