SCHOOL HEALTH CLINICS

The Anderson County Health Department nurses staff school health clinics. The services that are provided include: complete physical exams, hearing and vision screenings, scoliosis screenings for 8th graders, immunizations, health education, treatment of minor illnesses, first aid, over the counter medications, management of acute care and other medical issues. Our primary goal is early detection and prevention of disease.
